

The Colleen Barrett Award for Administrative Excellence is the Admin Awards most prestigious honor. The Award elevates and recognizes the Administrative Professional who embodies the "spirit" and proficiency of nationally renowned (former) Legal Secretary, Colleen Barrett of Southwest Airlines.

Colleen Barret began her career as the secretary to Herb Kelleher, the visionary founder of Southwest Airlines. Herb recognized and leveraged Colleen's gifts for management, strategy, leadership, and interpersonal relationships. At Southwest Airlines, it is understood that Herb was the brains behind the company but Colleen was its heart.

Over the course of her five-decade career at Southwest, Colleen served as a guiding force behind the company's legendary "people first" culture and ascended to become its President and COO. Colleen was not only the first woman to serve as President of a major airline, but she achieved the highest honor in the aerospace industry, as a recipient of the 2017 Wright Brothers Memorial Trophy in Washington, D.C.

The Admin Awards is proud to be a part of Colleen's legacy through the Colleen Barrett Institute, which now personally selects the Finalists and Winners across the U.S. of the coveted Colleen Barrett Award for Administrative Excellence.

NOMATION PHASE

With a growing list of over 150 diverse job titles reflecting the administrative function today, as long as the organization and Nominee are in mutual agreement that the job function is primarily administrative in nature, we accept the nomination regardless of the actual job title.

READY, SET. NOMINATE!

-9 Tips for Crafting a Winning Nomination

- 1. Start with an extraordinary Administrative Professional.
- **2.** Evaluate the Award Category that best reflects your Nominee's unique contributions and characteristics.
- **3.** Concentrate your nomination efforts on a single award category versus nominating an individual in multiple award categories, which could potentially dilute your efforts.
- **4.** Ensure the Admin's leader participates in the nomination process nominations submitted by their leaders are weighed more heavily by the judging panel.
- **5.** Be specific in answering the award category questions. Provide background, anecdotes, and details related to the Nominee's unique contributions against the award criteria you've selected.

- **6.** Nominations that advance in the competition average a 700-900 word count.
- **7.** Nominating can be a fulfilling team building initiative. Many companies come together and rally their Nominee's co-workers and colleagues during the nominations process.
- **8.** Rally support externally too. Encourage clients and vendors to also contribute to your Admin's nomination.

JUDGING PHASE

An independent Panel of Judges evaluates all Nominees, and rely solely on the written nomination(s) and any supporting materials you choose to upload with your nomination.



The Panel is comprised of Administrative Professionals, HR Leaders and Executives serving alongside the Colleen Barrett Institute in evaluating Nominees. Judges look for specific details, stories, anecdotes and quantifiable results. Neither sponsors, advisory board members nor the Admin Awards staff is involved in the judging process.



To produce the best possible outcome for every Nominee, the Judges reserve the right to advance a Nominee in any of the award categories should their nomination better reflect an award category different than the one originally selected. The Judge's discretion in award categories in no way negatively affects a Nominee's status in the competition.




